Monday	Objective: TSW create an imaginary animal by selecting parts of other animals and combining them to make a new and unique animal.
	Activities: all students should be working on their Animal Combine Drawings. Review steps with students: Students are to combine two different types of animals ( a dogs head on a wolf's body will <u>not</u> look strange but a giraffe's head on a wolf's body would). Choose an animal's head facing the same direction of the body of the other animal. The transition of the two should be smooth and unified Make the head and the body proportioned so it looks like a new breed of animal. Draw large – use the whole page and include a background. Draw all textures (feathers, fur, scales, etc). Draw all values using the white pencil on black paper like it is a pencil on white paper so the end result looks like it is a negative.
