

Monday	Objective: Analyze visual characteristics of personal objects and combine them in a collage and then develop this into a large drawing of these objects
	<p>Activities:</p> <p>Students should have collected personal objects from the list given to them at the beginning of last week. Objects that they should have either brought or Xeroxed included favorite book, favorite pattern, favorite food, favorite board or card game, favorite artist's work of art, personal photo, etc. Students are to combine these personal objects and Xerox copies of personal objects into a collage using principles of design.</p>
	Materials: Background paper, scissors, glue.
Tuesday	Objective: Analyze visual characteristics of personal objects and combine them in a collage and then develop this into a large drawing of these objects
	<p>Activities:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Continue to make your collage as stated above. • When you are through with your collage, decide on the overall dimensions that their design will have. This will depend on the items that they brought in and how they collage them. Each student's measurements will be different. Place a piece of transparency paper on top of their collage and grid it appropriately using black sharpies. • Decide on the appropriate enlargement of their design. Measure your white paper and grid it in proportion to their collage. Ask teacher for help if needed. • Draw your grid lines lightly in pencil. <p>When they are through with enlarging their design, erase all grid lines.</p>
	Materials: Transparency paper, Extra fine black sharpies, Rulers, Pencils, Erasers, White paper for enlarging their design.
Wednesday & Thursday	Objective: Analyze visual characteristics of personal objects and combine them in a collage and then develop this into a large drawing of these objects.
	<p>Activities:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Continue to grid your collage and your paper as stated above. • When you have gridded both your collage and your paper, start to enlarge your design to the white paper using the grid technique. Draw lightly. • When you are through with enlarging your design, erase all grid lines. • Start to add prisma color pencils using the color pencil techniques practiced last week.
	Materials: Transparency paper, Extra fine black sharpies, Rulers, Pencils, Erasers, White paper for enlarging their design, Prisma Color Pencils
