	Activities: Some students are still working on their second negative techniques using Prismacolors to create the opposite value placed in their first realistic self-portrait drawing thus creating a negative image. Students who are through with their negative space drawing will be working on their distorted grid drawings using the distortion of their choice.
	Materials: Negative Drawings - 9x6" white paper, 4½ x 6" template, black prismacolors. Student examples Grid Drawings -tracing paper drawing of their self portrait for griding. Rulers, pencils, erasers, white paper of different sizes for making their distorted grid
