Monday	Objective: TLW : formulate visual solutions to express personal themes in a mixed media project
	Activities: Continue their Never Dull & Glue Line Drawing assignment. When the background is finished, draw a figure or object that pertains to your statement with glue. It can be literal, but sometimes subtle, symbolic or metaphorical images are more intriguing. Let the glue dry before going on to the next part.  If you have applied the glue on Friday, you can now use the Never Dull to remove parts of the magazine images. Turn the fan on during this activity.
	Materials: Magazines, glue, background paper, Never Dull
Tuesday	Objective: TLW formulate visual solutions to express personal themes in a mixed media project
	Activities: Continue with the above activity. Students who are through can begin adding writing to their background (see Thursday's activity)
	Materials: Magazines, glue, Never Dull, black markers,
Wednesday & Thursday	Objective: TLW : formulate visual solutions to express personal themes in a mixed media project
	Activities: After removing parts of the magazine images with Never Dull, add writing to the background with a black pen. It can be your own statement, or you can use the lyrics from a song or a poem, etc. but in your title, give credit to the source i.e. "Revolutionary (Lyrics from Beatles' Penny Lane)". Again the words can play with the viewer by having them have to wonder why you choose these words to go with the images you have. Go back in with additional collage images or words, prisma colors, watercolors, etc.
	Materials: Magazines, glue, Never Dull, black markers, prisma colors, watercolors, etc.
Friday	Objective: TLW : formulate visual solutions to express personal themes in a mixed media project
	Activities: Continue to go back in with additional collage images or words, prisma colors, watercolors, etc. until you are satisfied with your final design. Make sure and write your social statement on the back with your name for turning in for grading.
	Materials: Magazines, glue, Never Dull, black markers, prisma colors, watercolors, etc.
